Our team consists of 3 partners (1 practice manager partner), 10 salaried GPs, a full skill mix of nurses, including 2 nurse prescribers, a senior clinical pharmacist, pharmacy technicians, frailty care coordinators, social prescriber, and practice counsellors. Not forgetting our fantastic reception and admin teams who work very hard to minimise administrative burden for our clinical team.

Staff turnover is very low, and the practice encourages feedback, to help us create a happy supportive practice environment.

We are a GP training practice (Severn Deanery) with 3 trainers. We regularly have ST2s and ST3s. In addition, we are a teaching practice (University of Bristol medical students and UWE/University of Gloucestershire nursing students).
